

# Rye Arts Center Music School holds spring recitals

During the month of April, the Rye Arts Center's Music School held its spring recitals. A total of 12 recitals took place, with 160 students participating. Students performed over 250 selections ranging from classical to pop-rock in style. Several of the students also performed original compositions. The Rye Arts Center offers music instruction for both children and adults in piano, voice, guitar, bass, drums, strings and woodwinds. Emphasis is placed on tailoring the lessons to meet the personal needs of each individual student. The instructors work closely with students to help nurture their abilities at all levels.

Instructors include graduates of schools such as Juilliard, Eastman, Berklee and SUNY Purchase Conservatory. Many are award recipients in international music competitions and are members of major symphony and opera orchestras. Several have performed with renowned musicians such as Michael Brecker, Tony Bennett, Ray Charles, George Benson, Alicia Keys, Houston Pearson and George Coleman.
